| | More than 90 SWU students have studied in TUJ's undergraduate programs since the partnership agreement was signed in 2016. A double-degree program agreement was also signed in 2019. |
| | This new partnership has led to the university offering of other collaborative academic programs, including joint workshops, symposiums, and joint lectures. More casual student-level interactions are also taking place. Our "Super Global Campus" with its inherent diversity, will certainly empower. |
