Submission	AdventureLearn is a gamified micro-learning platform specifically developed for freshmen with the aim of helping their transition to university learning.
	It aims to develop them in four key area's or "learning traits", which researchers have identified as crucial for effective learning to take place. These are Approaches to Learning & Studying, Well-Being, Grit & Resilience, and Mindset.
	By introducing this platform to all freshmen, we target a group of potentially at-risk students for early intervention, allowing them to pick up effective approaches to learning and good habits for well-being from the start of their university journey.
	More than 100 curated resources have undergone a rigorous process of inter-rater reliability for quality and relevance. There are mini quizzes for knowledge checks, and the platform also utilizes meaningful gamification where visualization of their progress can be seen; rewards are provided to encourage participation.
