| Submission | <p>Lorraine Hope is a Professor in Applied Cognitive Psychology. Professor Hope has supervised 17 completed PhDs (eight since 2019) and has five current PhD supervisees. She advises globally on investigative interviewing protocols, providing her students with additional research scope, outlets for publications and opportunities to engage with international practitioners.</p> <p>Above and beyond her doctoral supervisory responsibilities, Professor Hope established the Hope Applied Cognitive (HAC) lab further demonstrating her exceptional efforts to provide excellent mentorship.</p> <p>Professor Hope fosters opportunities for students to progress and make substantial contributions to the research field. She frequently collaborates with students in the production of research publications (26 of her publications are with students as first-authors).</p> <p>During the Covid-19 pandemic, she regularly checked-in with students and HAC lab members, providing both academic and well-being support. She accommodated meeting times in four different time zones and supported applications for PhD extensions due to extenuating circumstances.</p> |
