Submission	Professor Camilla Gilmore is in the vanguard of a generation of women academics combining outstandingly successful research careers with caring for a young family. As an international leader in mathematical cognition, her 50+ publications – cited over 3000 times – are primarily authored with PhD students. Her external funding of more than £8.5 million – virtually unheard of in her field – has supported numerous PhD students and early-career researchers, many of whom have won awards or their own independent funding and chosen to work with her over several years in multiple roles. Camilla has achieved all of this since completing her PhD in 2005; since 2009, she has taken three periods of maternity leave and otherwise worked at 0.6FTE. She inspires all of our PhD students and early-career researchers by expecting rigour in research and creating a supportive atmosphere that allows everyone, whatever their individual circumstances, to achieve that.
