Submission	A distinguishing feature of Aberdeen Business School has been the provision of work-based and work-related learning. This submission demonstrates how the school has harnessed its success in this area to develop further its work-based and work-related provision.  The school has enhanced the assessment of work-based learning by rolling out an e-portfolio to capture student learning in the workplace. Embedding a 12 month placement and related business consultancy project into the postgraduate provision along the lines of the already very successful undergraduate provision resulted in a significant increase in international student numbers.  The innovative design of our Graduate Apprenticeship courses has widened the diversity within our student body and has proved very popular with both employers and students.  Furthermore, engagement with two professional accountancy bodies, ICAS and ACCA, enabled the school to secure the pilot running in Scotland of the Accounting framework.
