Submission	De Montfort University Leicester (DMU) has an inner-city campus surrounded by public highways. Our estates strategy focused on these key principles: Connecting to the city centre, with high-quality spaces for people to enjoy Constructing iconic buildings that inspire Refurbishing key vacant landmark buildings Mill Lane pedestrianisation created a £2 million public space with: A greener campus A sustainable environment Minimised conflicts between pedestrians and cyclists The route of choice between the city centre, DMU and the West End The £62 million Vijay Patel Building consisted of refurbishment and new build to create a landmark building at the heart of campus, achieving a BREEAM Excellent rating. Our £4 million refurbishment of the Grade I listed Great Castle Hall gave an unused landmark a new lease of life through careful restoration.
	This successful delivery contributed to DMU recruiting its highest-ever cohort in 2017 and 2018 with 10,000 new students per year.
