Submission	Edinburgh Napier law students are not necessarily reflective of the profession. However, our Law department was determined to turn this on its head through an innovative two-pronged approach: a "Legal City Challenge" designed to get access to local firms for students who might be missing out on internships due to their backgrounds; and "Building An Inclusive Programme" which aimed to raise aspirations and remove perceived barriers to the profession among BAME students. The Legal City Challenge allowed students to learn the skills and attributes valued by firms, and see their learning in practice — a practical foot in the door. Meanwhile, Building An Inclusive Programme led to one student winning the Anderson Strathern Legal Practice Award, giving her an internship in a major law firm, and boosting her confidence as a young, black Scottish woman who had been told at school she would only ever work in a shop.
