Submission	LSE's new Centre Building at the heart of its central London campus was completed in 2019 and created inspirational spaces for students and staff to learn, socialise, study and collaborate.
	The Centre Building is an exemplar of sustainable design, achieving BREEAM 'Outstanding', an embodied carbon footprint reduced by 30%, and its innovative biofuel boiler delivers low carbon heat and energy. Enhancing the occupants' wellbeing was also a key part of the building's design, including excellent daylighting and natural ventilation.
	A key component of the scheme was the creation of a public square, which will be used for events, as a convening space, and the display of public art. And the building contributes to LSE's biodiversity aims, adding four accessible terraces and creating a green corridor of pollinator supporting plants.
	This is a key milestone in making the LSE campus more sustainable and inclusive, and a vibrant and stimulating place to work and study.
