Submission	The West London Food Innovation Lab (WLFIL) is project, co-funded by UWL and the European Regional Development Fund, that helps the food and drink industry navigate a highly competitive market. It offers start-ups and SMEs free access to expert advice, technical support, and culinary and product development. Aligned to the expertise and contacts of the University, WLFIL brings together three elements of culinary development: food preparation; extensive scientific laboratory services such as nutritional and texture analysis; and sensory evaluation and profiling (tasting). These specialist facilities would normally be outside of the reach of such small and emerging businesses. To date the project has supported nearly 80 businesses, developed 29 new-to-market products ranging from vegetarian and vegan foods, artisan breads, alternative protein products, to healthy street food desserts. It brings new levels of innovation, co-operation and partnership to support academics, businesses and the community in one virtuous circle.
