Submission	Handy Helpers is a unique initiative which uses the principles of co-creation and genuine partnership in response to the current needs of the Belfast community. The initiative is based upon building trusted relationships with local residents, charities and university departments, and it allows lesser known resident/community groups the opportunity to realise projects which otherwise would not happen due to lack of manpower and material resources. Since its inception in 2018, 682 Queen's students have delivered 86 activities, dedicating 3000+ volunteer hours to the betterment of the area. Activities include community gardening, litter-picks, making essential packs for homeless individuals, preparing and serving lunch to the elderly, sorting and upcycling donations, etc. The initiative has also been the driving force behind the recent regeneration of a number of severely neglected alleyways and turning them into vibrant social spaces for students and residents to enjoy together, significantly improving social cohesion in the area.
