Submission	UWS's unique AI collaboration with multinational firm Thales, could save lives by identifying missing people and providing warnings about buildings at risk of collapse.  The partnership, facilitated by Innovation Centre, CENSIS, has developed ground-breaking AI technology deployed in Police Scotland's remotely piloted aircraft systems (RPAS), which can find missing people in remote rural areas.  The system uses advanced cameras and neural computer networks to spot someone it is searching for, identifying individuals who appear as a 'speck' in the distance. The technology is the first of its kind used by police forces in the UK, providing real-time image analysis to identify humans.  UWS has since been able to build a remarkable 20-strong international academic team, providing the UK economy with artificial intelligence-driven business solutions. Dr Barry Connor, from Thales, said: "This project demonstrates the benefits of AI and machine learning in saving people's lives."
