Submission	Over a 5-year period, the £60m+ Future Campus Project transformed 30,000m² of unconnected and poorly maintained buildings into a state-of-the-art modern, student-focused campus that the UWL community could be proud of.  It created social and open learning spaces and specialist teaching areas with advanced simulation, as well as a library without boundaries, an integrated Students' Union, and a 300-seat flexible performance auditorium. The project culminated in 2019, with the opening of a new sports centre and Postgraduate House.  The impact of FCP has been truly remarkable, allowing us to develop innovative and exciting new courses, reducing the associated estate costs (26%) and hitting its 20% carbon reduction target 18 months ahead of schedule. It has undoubtedly raised the confidence, ability and reputation of UWL locally, nationally and internationally. All metrics are up: student satisfaction, league table position, financial income, helping put us as the top modern university in London.
