Submission	Disruptive thinking at its heart
	The last five years tell a compelling story about how UCL has become one of the leading universities in the UK in translating its knowledge and ideas externally, to contribute to economic growth and societal benefit.
	Its natural predisposition to 'disruptive thinking', and a recent steady focus to embed the frameworks and support needed to enable innovative behaviours in its students and academics, has meant UCL's entrepreneurial community is now thriving.
	This is reflected in the HE Business and Community Interaction (HE-BCI) data for 2018/19. For the first time, UCL spinouts attracted more external investment than any other university in the country (£579m), reflecting the quality of the technologies, as well as the expertise in creating, nurturing and growing companies. UCL graduate startups attracted £60m of external investment. And importantly, these startup and spinout companies collectively employed almost 3000 people.
