The programs enabled prisoners to complete their studies, work inside the prison, and prepared them for work in the community, following release.</p> <p>Studies at the university have proven that the number of prisoners who are returned to prison was large due to the lack of suitable work for them after their release. In addition to that, many prisoners have untreated psychological problems. For the project that the University of Basrah conducted in Basrah Centre Prison, school classes were set up and many prisoners will complete their university study online in Basrah University. Workshops cover a range of professional skills, including electrician training, furniture making, sewing and hairdressing. All these activities were officially recognised as valuable.</p>
