<b>Submission</b>	<p>UNIMAS Global High Impact Project Initiative (UGHIPS) was introduced to develop robust and adaptable international programmes that can withstand unprecedented contexts.</p> <p>The UGHIPS framework consists of three independent components that can function separately or in tandem. #GlobalHome focuses on enhancing our international community's campus experience. #GlobalHeartbeat unites our students with the local communities, and #GlobalFuture addresses the digital gap, a significant challenge in Industrial Revolution 4.0.</p> <p>The highlight of UGHIPS came in the form of a project themed "Solutions that Cross Frontiers" that incorporated all three components. We modified an existing International Student Mobility Programme (ISMP) -- an annual Global Problem-Based Learning (gPBL) project hosted by the Faculty of Engineering and their Japanese partner, Shibaura Institute of Technology (SIT) -- into a community-inclusive ISMP.</p> <p>In conclusion, this transformation is additionally encouraging that the wholesome experience can be organised fully through live streaming with little financial implications in connecting remote communities.</p>
