Submission	Our structured Resident Lifecycle Program complements a nurturing environment for over 1,000 Taylor's students across 50 nationalities living on-campus by offering a holistic living and development experience that supports their Emotional, Physical and Social Wellbeing. Three key areas of intervention were identified: (a) Support the unique needs of individual student residents (b) Nurture a stronger sense of community spirit among students (c) Increase students' sense of purpose by responding to community needs. From free skill workshops and communal pantries to a community service project to end menstruation poverty, residents were engaged offline and online despite the Covid pandemic's challenges. As a result, Resident Lifecycle events received an average NPS score of +92 from student attendees with 95% reporting they felt emotionally happy after the events. Over 1,000 refugee women were assisted by 40 students through the donation of reusable menstrual pads and visual tutorials.
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
