Submission	Taylor's Hostel launched Project LaunchPad in 2019 with the aim of eradicating menstruation poverty among female refugees residing in Malaysia. LaunchPad is the first initiative in Malaysia to address menstrual hygiene issues and period poverty among refugees.
	Female refugees experience numerous gender-specific difficulties navigating daily life, such as maintaining menstruation hygiene, which subsequently becomes a barrier for educational and employment possibilities. With the help of collaborations efforts between non-profit organisations and the corporate sector, we hope to create new narratives for refugee women and girls through this project.
