

THE Awards 2019 – Outstanding Estates Strategy Institution/Nominee De Montfort University Leicester Title De Montfort University's campus transformation Key personnel Umesh Desai, Director of Estates & Facilities Submission With De Montfort University Leicester (DMU) being an inner-city campus surrounded by public highways, the estates strategy focused on a number of key principles: Connecting to the city centre Creating high-quality public realm squares/spaces Constructing new iconic buildings that inspire Refurbishing key vacant landmark buildings The £62 million Vijay Patel Building consisted of refurbishment and new build to create a landmark building at the heart of campus, achieving a BREEAM Excellent rating. Mill Lane pedestrianisation created a £2 million public space with: A greener campus A sustainable environment Minimised conflicts between pedestrians and cyclists The route of choice between the city centre, DMU and the West End Our £4 million refurbishment of the Grade I listed Great Castle Hall gave an unused landmark a new lease of life through careful restoration. The successful delivery of this contributed to DMU recruiting its highest-ever cohort in September 2017, with 5,700 new students.
