

## THE Awards 2019 – Most Innovative Teacher of the Year Institution/Nominee Madeleine Davies, University of Reading Title Madeleine Davis - Innovative teaching methods that work Submission Dr Madeleine Davies is an Associate Professor of Women's Writing at the University of Reading who has a long track-record of student-centred innovative teaching. # In 2017 she led a project to diversify assessment, subsequently adopted online Learning Journals, and was so proud of the quality of her student's work that she worked with them to publish it in a book, Second Sight: The Margaret Atwood Learning Journals (UoR, June 2018) created a permanent record of the students' innovative critical writing and Atwood herself delighted the students by commending the book. Second Sight has generated similar initiatives both within and beyond the university and current students use the book as a model of 'good practice' journal writing. The project won the University Collaborative Award for Excellence in 2019 and Dr Davies is now working with students on a sequel, A Room of Our Own: The Virginia Woolf Learning Journals.
