

THE Awards 2019 – Outstanding Research Supervisor of the Year	
Institution/Nominee	Tong Sun, City, University of London
Submission	Professor Sun (OBE for services to engineering) creates supportive, stimulating, inspirational research environments for doctoral students. Most of her 30+ students have come from abroad.
	She has made outstanding contributions to their training, UK experience, ambition, motivation and early careers. They have produced excellent theses. Their post-doctoral achievements include lectureships, industry research posts and start-up companies. One student paper received 300 citations. Notably, she helped female students with families and won the Royal Society Athena Prize for promotion of diversity.
	As role model to female students, she helps them to be assertive in the male-dominated engineering profession. A poignant illustration of 'going the extra mile' was when diagnosed with serious illness, she ensured smooth transition of formal supervision but kept regular contact.
	Grant successes provide students with the best equipment, external experience and funding for conferences and Summer Schools overseas. She encourages students to plan early for their subsequent careers.
