

# Abstract guidelines



To be reviewed for presentation at Probiota, abstracts must be submitted no later than

## **Friday 26 November 2021\***

\*Submission of late abstracts after this date is at the organiser's discretion and will be reviewed for a poster only

Authors of accepted abstracts will be notified by 5<sup>th</sup> January 2022. Please do not enquire about the status of your abstract before this as a decision will not have been made. An oral presentation will be awarded on merit to the best abstract as decided by the Scientific Committee.

All accepted abstracts will be invited to provide a poster at the conference. You will be notified of which with your acceptance and presentation or poster guidelines will be provided. Those invited to give an oral presentation will be asked to provide further details (photo, biography, summary of work) for the programme.

There will be a dedicated poster viewing session on the evening of 23 February 2022. The oral presentation will take place during the conference programme on 24-25 February 2022.

### **Abstract format:**

- Abstracts must be submitted as a Word document.
- Word count: Maximum 250 words
- Font: Calibri 11
- Spacing: 1.5 lines
- Language: English

### **Abstract Content:**

- The abstract must be a new theory and clearly state: Objective, Method, Results & Conclusions
- The abstract should highlight the relevance to the theme(s) of this years conference
- The abstract must contain scientific grounding and be devoid of commercial bias
- Please clearly provide full contact details for the corresponding lead author including name, institution, phone, email.
- Nonstandard abbreviations should be defined.
- Clinical abstracts & titles must conform to CONSORT guidelines
- Abstracts containing clinical trials must have gone through an evaluation by an ethical committee. Trial registration number and review board details must be provided on the abstract

It is the author's responsibility to submit a correct abstract. Any errors in spelling, grammar or scientific fact in the abstract will be reproduced as typed by the author. **Any abstracts not conforming to the above parameters will be rejected. Please state when submitting your abstract if you only wish to be considered for a poster.**

By submitting abstracts you are granting permission for your abstract to be reviewed by the scientific committee and published in any or all of the following – conference material and website; NutraIngredients and other William Reed Business Media sites; IPA publications and publications of event media partners.
