1. PREPARE IN ADVANCE

Familiarise yourself with the entry questions before starting your submission and think of the best way to present your project. Remember to make a note of the deadline!

3. DRAFT YOUR WORK

It is best practice to draft the answers to the questions into a word document before submitting your entry. This way you'll never lose your hard work and always have a copy to refer back to.

7. ADD SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

Don't forget to include some images or documents to help support your entry, giving the judges the full picture.

8. THINK LIKE A JUDGE

6. PROOF YOUR WORK

Make sure you proofread your work and gain input from colleagues before submitting your entry.
