# RAI Amsterdam event entry conditions

Welcome to RAI Amsterdam. You are about to participate in an event facilitated or organised by the RAI. We look forward to seeing you. In this document you will find all essential information to gain access to events at the RAI, as well as how to participate in a safe and responsible manner.

## Registration and corona entry pass

If you want to visit an event in the RAI, you must first register to receive or buy a ticket. To gain access, you must be able to show a valid corona entry pass. In the Netherlands this is possible with the CoronaCheck-app that shows the EU digital Covid Certificate (DCC) through a QR code. This certificate is received when you have been fully vaccinated, have a negative Covid test (valid until 24 hours before participation) or have recovered from Covid-19. A valid paper version is also accepted. Please take note that a vaccination registration card (intended for your own administration) and 'yellow booklet' (form of vaccination passport) are not valid documents.

Visitors from countries outside Europe usually do not have a DCC and gain access with a certificate other than the DCC on paper. In the case of full vaccination, it is important to know that this proof is only valid if the vaccine is recognised by the European Union and/or WHO, drawn up in a European language.

## EU Digital Covid Certificate (DCC)

How you obtain this certificate differs per country. For example, it can be obtained through test centres, the health authorities, or through an e-health portal. The national health authorities of the countries provide the information on how to obtain the certificate.

All Member States of the European Union use the same model to recognize the electronic and paper versions. More information can be found on the website of the European Commission.



## Testing for Entry

If you are not (yet) fully vaccinated and you have no proof of recovery, you need a negative Covid test to gain entry to the event. This can be obtained at a “Testen voor Toegang” (Test for Entry) location. Please note that a test is only valid when it is undertaken no more than 24 hours - and no less than 2 hours - before entry.

There are testing facilities throughout the Netherlands, including RAI Amsterdam. These locations can be found on the website [www.testenvoortoegang.org](http://www.testenvoortoegang.org).

Do you have complaints, despite a valid negative test? With the safety and well-being of all participants in mind, we advise not to go to the event.

## Health check

In addition to showing your test result, you will also be asked to answer five questions about your health. If you answer all of these so-called triage questions with “no”, you may access the event.

## Privacy

You will be asked to show a valid ID to gain access. The test certificate is linked to your citizen service number. No personal data is stored by RAI Amsterdam.

## Hygiene measures

With a valid ticket you can now visit the event. The general hygiene rules remain in force.
