

Médecins Sans Frontières/Doctors Without Borders (MSF) is an international, medical humanitarian organisation working in more than 70 countries around the world.

Our medical teams act fast to save people's lives in conflict zones, natural disasters and epidemics. We provide free medical care to people who need it. It doesn't matter where they are from, which religion they belong to or what their political affiliations are. All that matters is they are human beings in need.

We have over 60,000 staff across the globe and around 90% of our staff are hired locally.

MSF UK do not accept government funding and we are funded by millions of private supporters, allowing us to respond quickly and remain fiercely independent.

Here's just an idea of what each pound can do to support vulnerable communities around the world:


- ▶ £10 covers the cost of an MSF doctor to work on a project for a day
- **£40** could provide antibiotics for 6 patients to prevent infection after an operation
- ▶ £80 would pay for emergency splints to look after broken bones of 10 people
- ▶ £95 provides antiretroviral drugs for a person living with HIV/AIDS for an entire year
- ▶ £150 covers the cost of a surgical kit, enabling an MSF surgeon to carry out an operation.


